in consideration of the sum of Thirty five hundred 100/100 (\$ 3500.00) DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W. H. Parish

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. H. Parish all that piece of land situated lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, within the state of South Carolina, lying on the North side of East Maple Street, and known as lot No. 26 of Section 5, on plat of Stone Land Company, made by J. E. Schreiber Engineer and recorded in the office of R. M. Todd Greenville County, in plat book rat page 337, and is described as follows, Beginning at a iron pin 360 feet from the East side of Bennett Street and running thence N 71-20 E. with said Maple Street being (60) feet to a stake, thence N 71-20 E. 40 feet to a stake, thence N 71-20 W. 60 feet to a stake, thence S 18-30 E. 200 feet to the beginning corner of said Maple Street being the same lot conveyed to C. C. Hobbs by the Landholder November the 28th 1916 and recorded in office of R. M. Todd Greenville County, in Book 41 at page 41 and there same deeded to T. F. Mount by the said C. C.
