NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That *J. J. Sanford* in the State aforesaid  
 in consideration of the sum of *Fifty hundred* DOLLARS,  
 to *me* in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by *J. M. Elzath*

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said *J. M. Elzath* all that certain parcel and lot of land situate and being in the State and County aforesaid, in the town of *Greenville*, on the North side of Merchant Street, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:  
 Beginning at an iron pin on Merchant Street, and running thence up the said street, nearly east Sixty-five (65) feet to corner of lot no 7; thence along the line of lot no 7 Two hundred and nine and seven tenths (209.7) feet to a stake on the ditch bank; thence with ditch bank, nearly east, fifty-five and eight tenths (45.8) feet to a stake on corner of lot no 5; thence along the line of lot no 5 Two hundred and thirteen and one tenth (213.1) feet to the beginning corner, and being designated as lot no 6 of the subdivision of the Merchant Plaza, and more fully described on a plat prepared by *H. C. Jones*, and some lot surveyed to me by *F. L. Nichols* et al., my deed dated December 17th, 1918, recorded in Book 34, page 158 in office of R.M.C. in and for *Greenville County*.

heirs and assigns, against *me* and *my wife* *J. M. Elzath*, his heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
