NOW KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W. P. Conyers and J. C. Gossler,
31st
 in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred and Seventy-five DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Ben Smith

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Ben Smith, all that certain lot of land situate on the south side of Jenkins Street in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, and being more particularly described as follows:
 Beginning at a stake on the south side of Jenkins Street, corner of lot 720.2, being approximately 115 feet East of an alley and running thence with Jenkins Street S. 68 E. 55 feet to the corner of lot 720.4, thence with line of lot 720.4, S. 26.2 W. 128 1/2 feet to a stake; thence N. 68 W. 55 feet to a stake corner of lot 720.2; thence with line of lot 720.2, N. 23 E. 124 1/2 feet to the beginning corner. Being known and designated as lot 720.3, of the H. K. Howell property and being a portion of the land conveyed by H. K. Howell to W. P. Sewell, by deed dated and recorded in the P. M. C. office in Vol. S.S. page 438 and being the same lot of land conveyed to D. L. Johnson, by W. P. Sewell by deed dated June 29th. 1914 and from D. L.
