(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Mary Grace Slattery, Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of Whitner Street 149.3 feet from Clement sidewalk on corner of Whitner Street and Hampton Avenue, running thence along Whitner Street N. 28 degrees 30' minute E. 54 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 160 degrees 50' minute W. 106.4 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 29 degrees 55' minute W. 54 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 60 degrees 50' minute E. 108 feet to the beginning, a corner on Whitner Street. Said lot being bounded on the East by Whitner street or the north by Miss Mallett's property, on the West by Williams and Bramlett, and on the South by the Bramlett property.
