NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. No. G. Page, of the County of Greenville  
in the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Jasper M. Page  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
Jasper M. Page, All that certain lot or parcel of land situate  
just outside of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville  
County and State aforesaid, known as lot No. 101 on plat of  
survey of land of W. M. Norwood, known as Norwood Heights  
made by J. N. Southern Surveyor, bearing date October 9th  
1906, and recorded in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County  
S. C. in Plat Book "A", page 133, and having a frontage  
on Main Street of fifty (50) feet, and a depth of one hundred  
and fifty (150) feet, and being the same lot of land con-  
veyed to me by W. M. Norwood by deed dated, November 5th  
1914, and recorded in said R. M. C. office in Deed Book  
Vol. 27, page 478.
