NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That of Greenville County, in consideration of the sum of Thirty four hundred fifty and no dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Morris Lurey,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Morris Lurey, and his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County and City of Greenville, in the Second Ward of said City, on the North side of East Stone Avenue, having the following vertices and bounds, according to a survey and plat thereof made by E. A. Adams, Surveyor, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of E. Stone Avenue (said iron pin being 110 feet distance from the corner of Main Street and Stone Avenue), and running thence N. 19° E 132 feet to a stake; thence about S 73° E 53 feet and 8 inches to a stake in line of A Katz lot; thence along Katz line about S 17° W 132 feet to a stake on Stone Avenue; thence along said Stone Avenue N. 73° W 54 feet 4 inches to the beginning corner; this being a portion of the land conveyed to me by W. H. Valentine by deed dated May 26th, 1911, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County and State in Vol. #17 of Deeds, at page 326, to which reference is hereby made.
