Borroughs, all that lot or parcel of land in the state and County aforesaid, in Ward Two of Greenville City, and having a frontage on the north side of East North Street of fifty-three (53) feet, and beginning on said East North Street at the corner of the lot of land belonging to B. S. Allen (formerly of D. Woodside) and running thence along the line of B. S.
