(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said B.O. Woodward, all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Ward One, City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and being better described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin at fence post on the East side of Academy Street 152 feet from the south side-walk on Buncombe St.; thence along property of Mrs. Annie M. Owen S. 62-53 E. 75 feet to a fence post; thence along line of fence S. 33-43 E. 31.3 feet to fence post; thence continuing with fence (along line of Mrs. P.D. Gilreath, Est.) S. 23-15 W. 54 feet to fence post on rear line, corner of Stribling property; thence along Stribling Property N. 64-26 W. 105.3 ft. to center of fence post on the east side of Academy St.; thence along the east side of Academy St. N. 26-0 E. 71.7 ft. to fence post and iron pin at point of beginning.
