(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said *L. R. Dean*. A certain tract or lot of land situated in Oaklawn Township, County and state aforesaid containing twenty-three and eight-tenths acres more or less, being lot #5 of the subdivision of the Anderson Estate as shown by plat of same by B. Hawes Jr. Nov. 28, 1913 recorded in office of R.M.C. Greenville, S.C. Being the same land deeded by A. M. Anderson, Ex. of estate of M. H. Anderson to H. T. Beam Jan. 14, 1918, recorded in Book #44 page 171 R.M.C. Office Greenville, S.C. and deed this day to B. C. Babb by H. T. Beam and to John A. Hudgens by B.C. Babb and recorded herewith.
