KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That W. M. Kinney of the County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of \$1,000.00, DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by M. G. Burns

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said M. G. Burns All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in Greenville Township, State and County aforesaid, on the East side of Keevee Avenue, and on the South side of Saluda Street and having the following lines and bounds, to wit: Beginning at the corner of said Saluda Street and Keevee Avenue and running thence with said Saluda Street S. 63° E. 172 feet to gully, thence with said alley S. 27° W. 60 feet toward gully; thence N. 63° W. 172 feet to Keevee Avenue; thence N. 27° E. 60 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 10,320 square feet more or less, and being known as lot Number 33 of subdivision of land known as South Cherokee Park, as shown by plat in R.
