

W. C. Bull DEED TO Edward C. Lourdes

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That,

d, W. C. Bull

in the State aforesaid,

 Ten Dollars and other Valuable Consideration DOLLARS,

 at and before the sealing of these presents by, Edward C. Lourdes

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Edward C. Lourdes, all that piece, parcel and lot of land, situate in the City and County of Greenville, State aforesaid, being a portion of the Crowley Place, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake on Mc Gee Street, joint corners of lots Nos. 44 and 45, and running thence N. 21° 45' W. fifty (50) feet and ten inches to a stake at joint corners of lots 45 and 46; thence along line of said lots N. 80 W. one hundred and fifty five (155) feet to a stake on a ten foot alley, thence S. 21° 45' E. fifty-two (52) feet and six inches to stake on said alley joint corners of lots Nos. 44 and 45, thence N. 80 E. One hundred and fifty-five (155) feet to a stake at beginning. Being lot No. 45 according to Survey of W.A. Adams, January 1910, and being the same lot of land conveyed to L. J. Walker by W. B. Gleam, and L. J. Walker to W. R. Childers and W. C. Bull, by deed dated March 12th, 1912, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 19, page 106, and subsequently the interest of W. R. Childers having been conveyed to me by deed dated July 6th, 1912, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 19, page 493. Upon condition however, which is a part of the consideration of this deed that the purchaser, nor his grantees heirs or assigns shall not erect a building costing less than Fifteen Hundred Dollars complete, nor within fifteen feet of line of sidewalk abutting said property, which consideration hereby declared to be a condition subsequent.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Edward C. Lourdes,
