(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. T. Gaylord and his heirs and assigns: - All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land in County and State aforesaid, containing 6 1/2 acres, more or less, and bounded by lands of J. T. Thackston & P. Battlefield W. T. Gaylord and others, Beginning at a stone on corner of lands formerly owned by Wm. Bassett on East side of road, and running thence N. 32 E. 6° 70' to J. T. Thackston corner, thence S. 86 1/2 E. 20.30 to a stone on branch, thence down said branch S. 66 E. 7.67 to a bend, thence N. 65 E. 6.66 to a bend, thence N. 74 3/4 E. 5.50 to an Ash near branch, thence S. 52 E. 21.28 to a stone, thence N. 40 W. 32.00 to the beginning and being a part of lands conveyed to Margaret Thackston by R. M. Dwingel April 27th 1862 and being same conveyed to W. T. and C. A. Thackston by J. T. Thackston and others by deed recorded in Office R. M. C. for Greenville County in Book 11 at page 48.

As a part of the consideration for this conveyance it is understood and agreed that W. T. Gaylord, the grantee, will open a road beginning at the stone of said W. T. Gaylord and run in a North Easterly direction to the boundary of J. T. Thackston's line.

A mortgage upon the aforesaid premises in this day given by the grantee to the grantor for \$23,000 as a part payment of purchase price.
