KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Mamie J. Smith, as Executrix, and J. M. Wood and H. W. Chiles, as Executors, of the last Will and Testament of Thos. G. Smith, deceased, by virtue of the powers in said Will, in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand DOLLARS, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. L. Rhodes

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. L. Rhodes, his heirs and assigns: All of that lot of land situate on the West side of Buncombe Street, in the City and County of Greenville, S. C. known as lot No. 1 of the Thomas G. Smith property, and beginning at an iron pipe on said street at corner of the Whitmire property and run thence S. 51.52 W. 73.6 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 28.43 W. 64.4 feet to a fence post; thence S. 49.54 E. 20.8 feet to a fence post; thence N. 53.54 E. 145 feet to an iron pipe on said Buncombe Street; thence N. 34.19 W. along said Street, 51 feet to the beginning corner, as shown by plat of R. E. Dalton made March 16th, 1916, together with perpetual right of way eight feet wide to and from the above described lot to Academy Street, referred to in deed by us to C. W. and Rose E. Waring, dated the 8th day of August, 1917, and recorded in Vol. 52, page 21, and as shown by plat revised, May, 1917
