at and before the sealing of these presents by J. F. White

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. F. White his heirs and assigns, all those two certain lots, pieces or parcels of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid in Greenville Township, about one mile West of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville known and designated as lots Nos. 129 and 130 on a plot of City View made by W. A. Adams and recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County on March 18, 1911 in plat book (A) at page 461 and having the following lines and boundaries to wit: Lot No. one hundred and twenty-nine beginning at a stake on the West side of McD. Ave. 350 ft. southward from Summit St. and running thence N. 89 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 140 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. with lines of lot No. 128 to a stake on Hunt St. thence along Hunt St. S. 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. a little more than fifty ft. to a stake on the corners of lot No. 130 hereinafter described, thence along line of last mentioned lot S. 89 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 144 ft. to a stake on McD. Ave. thence along said Ave. N. 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 65 ft. to the beginning corner and being one of the lots decided to me by W. C. McDaniels, May 14, 1918 recorded in Vol. 51, page 128. Lot No. 130 beginning at a stake on the West side of McD. Ave. two hundred and fifty ft. northward from the North West corner of McD. Ave. and Oscar St. our joint corners of lots Nos. 130 & 131 thence along McD. Ave. N. 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. fifty ft. to a stake on corner of lot No. 129 thence along line of last mentioned lot N. 89 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 144 ft. to a stake on Hunt St. thence along Hunt St. S. 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. to a stake on the corner of lot No. 131 thence along line of last mentioned lot S. 89 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. to a stake the beginning corner and being the same lot conveyed to me by W.
