(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

A. B. Cannon, all that certain piece parcel and tract of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Highland Township, adjoining lands of I. F. Reese, I. F. Few and being a part of the same land conveyed to I. F. Reese and Ignatius Few, by Benjamin Few and Ignatius Few Executors, by deed bearing date of Nov. 12<sup>th</sup> 1883 and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. of Greenville County in Vol. 1152 at page 11 and having the following courses and distances, meters and fownde,  
Beginning on a stone and chestnut stump, I. F. Few's corner and runs thence N. 47° W. 31.85 chs. to a stone st. thence S. 52 1/2° W. 11.40 chs. to a pine knot and iron pin on I. F.
