(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

*H. T. Pitman*,

All that certain piece of land situate, lying and being on Oneal Street in Ward #5 of the City of Greenville County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at and upon a pin on Oneal Street, corner lot conveyed to H. T. Knut and running thence with his line N. 70.30 E. 76.6 feet to an iron fence on eight foot alley; thence with said alley N. 19.30 E. 43 feet to the center of wall of brick stable of J. T. Blasingame, thence S. 370.30 W. 78.6 feet to an iron pin on Oneal Street; thence with Oneal Street S. 19.30 E. 43 feet to the beginning corner together with all the rights and privileges granted in and to the alley in the rear of said property as stated in Deed of J. T. Blasingame to me dated October 30th - 1918, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 35 page 572.

The grantor is to pay all taxes that are now due, including the year 1918, and possession is to be given to the grantee on the 1st day of January 1919.
