 in hand paid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
*Millega Milton*, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land  
 situated, lying and being in the State of South  
 Carolina, and Greenville County, in *Spivey*  
 Township, on Martin's Creek, & Reedy River, about  
 twenty three miles from the City of Greenville, about  
 five miles of Fork Shoals, about 8 miles from  
 Fountain Inn, and about 10 miles from Elgin, near  
 the road which runs from *M. Kittick Bridge* to  
 Hillside Church, and about 1/2 mile from church,  
 bounded by lands of Mrs. Alice Tollison on the North  
 on East by lands of Mrs. Alice Tollison and by Martin's  
 Creek, on South by lands of Bodie Tollison, and on  
 West by lands of James Woods and having the following  
 lines and bounds according to a survey made by  
 Walter Nash about the month of Nov. 1914 to wit,  
 Beginning at a Stake on James Woods line, (Bodie  
 Tollisons corner), thence N. 6 E. 12.66 chs. to a stone  
 by Mrs. Alice Tollison's corner, thence S. 84 1/2 E. 28.00  
 chs. to a stone in Martin's Creek, thence down  
 said creek S. 19 1/2 W. 3.35 chs. to stone in Creek
