to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by F. M. Todd

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said F. M. Todd, All that piece parcel or tract of land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid near Simpsonville S. C. and hath the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning on a sweet gum bush and running thence S. 53 3/4 W. 3.00 to bend in gully; thence S. 30 W. 1.00 to bend; thence S. 74 3/4 W. 2.20 to bend; thence N. 29 W. 1.45 to bend; thence S. 35 1/4 W. 1.55 to bend; thence S. 45 1/4 W. 3.09 to bend; thence S. 53 1/4 W. 1.70 to bend; thence S. 54 3/4 W. to iron pin center of C. & W.
