(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release  
unto the said R. L. Dill

Two-thirds interest in all that certain piece  
parcel and lot of land situate lying and  
being in the State and County aforesaid on waters  
of Beaver Dam Creek, and being a part of the  
same land conveyed to J. S. Reid, deceased by  
Alexander P. Parker by deed bearing date of September  
8th, 1890, and recorded in the office of the R. M.C.  
for Greenville County in Vol. XX at page 302, and  
more fully described as follows: Beginning at a  
stone on the South East side of the old State Road  
(formerly a perennious) and hence thence S. 72° 4' W.  
19.00 chs. to a stone on R. L. Dill's line; thence N.  
59° E. 7.20 chs. to an iron pin on East bank of a  
branch; thence down the said branch N. 48° E. 9.62  
chs. to an iron pin in center of said branch;  
thence continuing down the said branch as  
the line in a north easterly course 6.95 chs. to a  
stake across Beaver Dam Creek, opposite the  
mouth of the aforementioned branch, on Mr. James  
Langley's line; thence with the said line S. 51° 34' E.  
4.70 chs. to a W. O. (gone) in the fill of the new  
State Road; thence S. 11° W. 3.20 chs. to the beginning  
corner, containing six and one seventh (6 1/7) acres
