KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That L. A. Crisp of Simpsonville,
Greenville County

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
Two Dollars and other valuable Consideration DOLLARS
to one in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by J. C. Smith

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. C. Smith, his heirs and assigns:-

all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land, lying being and situated in County and State, aforesaid, just out of the Town of Simpsonville on the west side of the C. & W. C. R.R. on both sides of the main street adjoining lands of J. H. West, Mrs. S. E. McAllister and the C. & W. C. Railway, beginning at an iron pin on the C. & P. and running with said R.R. track N. 8 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 3.43 chains to iron pin, thence S. 85 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 5.00 to iron pin, thence S. 8 $\frac{3}{4}$ W. 3.43 to iron pin, thence N. 85 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 5.00 to the beginning corner, containing one and one-half acres (1 1/2), more or less, allowance being made for 30 ft. street through same - being same lot conveyed to W. E. Crisp by Mrs. S. C. McAllister and others by Deed dated May 4th 1909 and placed on record in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 4 at page 444, and later conveyed to me by W. E.
