all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in the Township of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a point on Cop Street, corner of lot no. 21 and 22, 138 1/2 feet; thence N. 76-15 E. 60 feet to corner of lot no. 19; thence along this line 136.8 feet to said Cop street; thence along said Cop Street 60 feet to the beginning corner being between lot no. 20 on a plat of land called "Hillcrest" surveyed by Hill D. Morris.
