(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release
 unto the said *S. L. Davis and his heirs and assigns,*

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate
 lying and being on the south side of Stall street, in the
 City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, and
 being Record # lot #4, as shown in what recorded
 Plat Book "A", page 198 in R. M. C. Office for said
 County and State, and having the following metes
 and bounds, to-wit; Beginning at an iron post
 on Stall Street, corner of lot #5, as shown in said
 plat and running thence with Stall Street 566 3/4
 ft. 46 3/4 feet to corner of lot #1; thence with the line
 of lots #1 and 2, S. 25 1/4 E. 100 feet to an iron post;
 thence N. 66 3/4 E. 46 3/4 feet to an iron post on the line
 of lot #5; thence with the line of said lot #5
 N. 23 1/4 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner; and
