All that certain piece parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in Highland Township, County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone on the Jordan road and running thence N. $74\frac{1}{4}$ E. 1.78 to a stone; thence with the S. W. Naldrop line S. $31\frac{1}{2}$ E. 16.00 to a stone; thence with the Donaldson line S. $87\frac{1}{2}$ W. 22.10 to a Hickory tree on Jordan road; thence with said road 8.03 to the beginning corner and containing Thirty One $\frac{1}{4}$ acres, less ^{the} land described of less.
