(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said A. L. Ford, all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, near the town of Keeler, in Chick Springs Township, and being a part of lot 13 and 14 of the Cunningham-Haynesworth-Burgiss division, as shown by plat made by W. H. Willis Dec 12, 1915, Being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a stake on the East line of lot No 13, said stake standing 86 degrees 22 minutes West 29.5 feet from the intersection of an unnamed street with 15 foot alley, and runs with West margin of said unnamed street 76 degrees 22 minutes East 37 feet to the center of the 15 foot alley, thence with the center of said alley 76 degrees 40 minutes West 9.8 feet to a stake, thence 817 degrees West with the East line of lot No. 14, 45 feet to a stake on the center of 15 foot alley, thence with the center of said alley in an eastern direction 98 feet to the beginning.
