(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. M. Woods, his heirs and assigns forever:

All those five (5) certain lots of land lying, being and situated in Greenville Township, in the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina, Numbered and designated as lot number one, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, and eighteen (15, 16, 17 & 18) of Block A, and lot number ten (10) of Block H of "Highland Terrace" subdivision as shown by plat of same made August 1917 by R. C. Dalton, Engineer. The said "Highland Terrace", of which the first (5) lots herein conveyed are parts, was conveyed to me by H. P. McGee, H. P. Company and H. J. Henderson, Trustees, by deed recorded in Book 40 at page 248 in office of R. M. L. for Greenville County, S. C.

I doth this conveyance is made and accepted upon the following understanding and agreement: 1st. The property is not to be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to persons of African descent. 2nd. That no liquor or ardent spirit are to be sold on the property.

3rd. That no sale shall be made of the lots sold or any part thereof which would constitute a nuisance or injure the value of any of the neighboring lots.

4th. That no dwelling house shall be built on the lots to cost less than two thousand dollars, but any person may use two or more lots placing one residence thereon.

5th. That no building shall be erected on or the street than the building line, unless twenty-one feet from street lot width on lot faces.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said

W. M. Woods, his

heirs and assigns, forever.
