Four Thousand and *no/100 (\$4000.00)*to *George P. Manos* and *George Bobotis*at and before the sealing of these presents by *George P. Manos* and *George Bobotis*

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said *George P. Manos* and *George Bobotis*, share and share alike: all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on the corner of Woodside Avenue and the old Pendleton at Pickens Road, in the County of *Beeenville* and State of South Carolina; and containing the following metes and bounds, to wit:— Beginning at the corner of the said Woodside Avenue and the old Pendleton at Pickens Road and running thence with Woodside Avenue thirty (30) feet, more or less, to corner of lot now or formerly owned by A. C. Batson, thence thence with his line, fifty (50) feet to corner of lot of A. C. Batson and C. C. Stone, thence northward C. C. Stone's line towards the old Pendleton at Pickens Road twenty-four (24) feet to corner, thence in a straight line to the beginning corner.

It is understood and agreed that the foregoing warranty clause here after only concerns the frontage on said Woodside Avenue to be twenty-four (24) feet.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
