(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said H. F. Henderson, his heirs and assigns forever; all that piece, parcel or lot of land lying, situated and being near the incorporate limits of the City of Greenville, beginning at stake, corner of Poplar Avenue and Easley Bridge Road, and running thence along said road N 44 $\frac{1}{2}$  E fifty-nine feet to corner of lot No. 5; thence along line of lot No. 5 S 40 $\frac{1}{2}$  W one hundred and ninety feet to a stake, thence east along parallel line with front line of said road fifty-nine feet to said Poplar Avenue; thence along Poplar Avenue N 40 $\frac{1}{2}$  W one hundred and ninety feet to the beginning, being lot No. 6, a plot of land division of land formerly owned by H. V. Thomas and others made by H. V. Hudson June 20th, 1905. Also that other lot beginning at stake, corner of above described lot and the Easley Bridge Road, thence along said road about N 44 $\frac{1}{2}$  E fifty-nine feet to stake on lot No. 4, thence in a southeast direction along lot No. 4 one hundred and ninety feet to a stake, thence in a southwest direction fifty-nine feet to stake on lot No. 6, thence along said lots one hundred and ninety feet to the beginning, being known as lot No. 5 on plan above referred to.
