to *me* in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by *J. G. Milford* of County & State aforesaid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said *J. G. Milford*. All of my right, title + interest, which is one half in those two certain lots of parcels of land situated in Greenville County, State of So. Ca. in the Sixth Ward of the City of Greenville and known as lots & number fifteen (15) and fifteen (15) on plot of the estate of Mrs. T. E. Harris made by H. D. Nease on Oct. 12th 1912 + recorded in office R. M. C. in plot Book C'it page 361 Lot No 15 fronting on both Edwards and Thruator Ste. Sixty feet with a depth of 110 ft. Lot 7205 fronts on Augusta Street (58 1/2) feet fifty eight + five tenths ft. + on Edwards st (73 1/2) so it is bounded + thirty six feet.

Being the lots conveyed to H. T. Henderson + J. G. Milford by *John E. Willis + L. G. Harris* on the 4th Oct. 1916 plus all of my interest which is one half in that certain lot situated in Greenville County, State of So. Ca. in the Sixth Ward of the City of Greenville + has the following courses and distances commencing at a stake joint rear of Henderson + Milford + H. E.
