KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we Annie B Walker et al

to 15000 DOLLARS  
in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by D L Johnson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said D L Johnson, all those fo<sup>r</sup> certain pieces or parcels, so tracte of land, situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, and described as follows: No. 1 That certain tract of land containing 40 acres more or less, and now owned by Annie B Walker, who having purchased the same from D C Verner, Master, on May 7th, 1900, the deed for same being recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 66 & Page 129. For description by owner and bounds see shid deed.

No. 2 That certain tract of land containing 3.5 acres, now owned by L C Walker, which was purchased by him from B W Miller on January 23, 1909, the deed for same being recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 89 & Page 583. For full description see said deed.

No. 3 That certain tract of land containing 2.75 acres more or less, now owned by L C Walker and purchased by him from J J McSwain on December 15, 1905, the deed for same being recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 95 & Page 581. For full description to property see said deed.

No. 4 That certain parcel of land containing 5 acres more or less, now owned by L C Walker and purchased by him from J J McSwain on December 15, 1905, the same being recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 111 & Page 582. For full description see said deed.

It is understood and agreed that D L Johnson will take immediate possession of the premises herein conveyed, and that the interest of the grantors in all rents, crops, etc. upon said premises for the year 1917 shall belong to the said D L Johnson.

For value, I hereby release from the debt of the mortgaged held by me and recorded in R. M. C. office Vol. 58 pages 54 & 56 respectively for the principal of \$7500<sup>c</sup> each, the real estate herein contained.
