WHEREAS Margaret Hendrix heretofore sold to W. W. Smith
the tract of land herein after described in a deed dated 17th
day of June 1893 recorded in book A page 162, and
subbed by mistake the name of T. H. Hendrix thereon, the date
beginning of the deed was last to Hendrix now deceased
for the purpose of removing the cloud & correcting said error
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

I, Margaret A. Hendrix of Greenville, Co.

In the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
Three hundred & seventy five DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by W. W. Smith of Greenville Co.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. W. Smith, all that tract pieces or parcels of land situated, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, adjoining lands of Margaret A. Hendrix separate from the said Smith by a narrow strip about 121 feet wide, left for a wagon road and from W. A. Goldightly by the public road leading from Battenville to Greenville containing eighteen and three quarters acres, be the same more or less having the following metes marks and bounds, Beginning on a st 3 1/2 N M on the public road in front of W. A. Goldightly's dwelling house and running thence N 33 1/4 W 9.28 ch to st 3 1/2 N M, thence N 39 1/4 W 7.70 ch to a small swamp in 3 1/2 N M, thence N 43 1/2 E. 4.75 to st 3 1/2 N M, thence N 12 E. N 5.75 ch to a cluster of birches on South bank of Rocky Creek branch waters of Broad River, thence with said Creek N 54 E 4.74 ch to a birch 3 1/2 N M on bank of Creek, thence S 54 E. 5.10 ch to st 3 1/2 N M, thence S 1 E 10.00 ch to st 3 1/2 N M, thence S 89 E 5.88 to st 3 1/2 N M and about 12 feet from Thos. Smith line, thence S 2 E. 4.25 to st 3 1/2 N M on public road, thence with said road to beginning corner.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said W. W. Smith his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind

myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said W. W. Smith his

heirs and assigns, against me my

heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
