KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the L. T. Spillers and Paul
Owens of Greenville County

to

Spartanburg

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. H. Lee and F. A. Daugherty: All that piece, parcel and tract of land situated lying and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, in Glassy Mountain Township, containing 90 (Ninety) acres more or less, and having the following lines and bounds, and courses and distances, to wit: -
Beginning on a white Oak and running thence N. 38 degrees to a chestnut; thence S. 70 E. 15.50 to a stone; formerly a Spanish Oak; thence S. 57 (57) 15 degrees to a stone, formerly a white Oak stump; thence East 15.50 to a chestnut; thence South 9. E. 15.50 to a Red Oak; thence S. 55 W. 16 to a Chestnut Oak; thence N. 23. W. 4 chains to a Hickory; thence S. 67 W. 7.50 to a Hickory; thence S. 70 W. 16 chs. to the beginning; and bounded by lands of L. C. Barton, George Phillips, Pres. Barnett, formerly Ballou, Holland Howard and Rebecca Rector.
