KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, H. H. Griffin, of Greenville County, S.C.

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
Five DOLLARS

to me in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by The Trustees of Simpsonville M.E.C. Church, South, Simpsonville, S.C. Greenville County

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Trustees of Simpsonville M.E.C. Church, South, Simpsonville, S.C. and their successors, all those certain pieces, parcels, lots or tracts of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville in Austria Township, and in the town of Simpsonville, South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lots Numbers Six (6), Seven (7) and eight (8) in Block "B", and fronting on Main Street 150 feet and running through 210 to North Street, the above lots being more fully shown by a plat made by T. A. Adams, Surveyor November 22nd, 1916 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for said County and State in Plat Book E, at page 15, these being the same 3 lots of land conveyed to me by F. C. Todd by Deed dated 29th, day of November 1916 and recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County, in the State of South Carolina in Volume #41, of Deeds, at page 463, to which reference is hereby made.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Trustees of Simpsonville M.E.C. and their successors in Office heirs and assigns, forever.

I do trust, nevertheless that said premises shall be used, kept, maintained and disposed of as a place of divine worship for the use of the Ministry and membership of the Methodist Episcopal Church, South, subject to the discipline, usage and ministerial appointments of said Church as from time to time authorized and declared by the General Conference of said Church and by the Annual Conference within whose bounds, the said premises are situated.

AND do hereby bind

myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Trustees of Simpsonville M.E.C. Church, South, and their successors in office heirs and assigns, against

myself my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
