 all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land  
 situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville in Greenville City, in Ward Six of said City, known  
 and designated as Lot No (4) found on Plan of  
 Estate of Mrs. F. E. Harris, made by Will D.  
 Neve, October 22nd, 1913, and recorded in R. M. C.  
 Office for Greenville County in Plat Book C,  
 at page 261. Said lot fronting on Augusta  
 Street Sixty feet with side lines of one hundred  
 Seventy-nine and one hundred sixty feet  
 respectively, and a width of fifty seven  
 feet on the back line. This being the same
