at and before the sealing of these presents by Mannie L. Phillips

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Mannie L. Phillips, all those certain lands in the State and County aforesaid described as follows: First, all that lot of land in Chickas Spring Township beginning at a stake on the South-West side of The National Highway corner of lot number 74 (E. M. Wharton's subdivision) thence along said Highway N. 60-16 E. 25 feet to a stake on said Highway cor. of lot 76, thence N. 29-44 W. 50 ft. to a stake in line of lot 73 thence along line of lot 73 S. 60-16 W. 25 ft. to cor. of lot 74, thence S. 29-44 E. 50 ft. to beginning cor. This is the same lot conveyed to me by G. M. Todd by his deed dated September 29, 1917, recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in deed book 43 page 176. This being lot no. 75 of Wharton's subdivision.
