the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. Manning Cooley, three Reins, and acreage

forever the following described real Estate to wit: "All that certain piece, place or tract of land situate, lying and being in Duckline Township, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, containing 43.16 acres, more or less, and being known and designated as tract No. 3 of the Hiram Cooley estate, as surveyed and platted by H. D. Nevis, King, and having the following boundaries and boundaries and distances: 130 feet running at a stone at the Southwest corner of tract 210, Pt. of said plat, and running thence along the line of said tract 340.2, N. 26 E. 1360 feet to a stone at the Northwest corner of said tract 340.2; thence N. 61 1/2 W. 1470 feet to a stone, thence S. 23-3-8 W. 1360 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 63-45 E. 1400 feet to stone at the beginning corner."
