in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said *E. H. Biggs*, Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in
said town of the city of Greenville, commencing at
corner of Brown and Clifford Streets, and running
thence along Brown Street, in a Northwesterly direction
fifty-eight (58) feet to the corner of Hattie C. Williams
lot, thence with the line of Hattie C. Williams in an
Easterly direction one hundred (100) feet to the lot
formerly owned by the late John H. O'Neal; thence
with said O'Neal's lot in a Northerly direction sixty
six (66) feet to Clifford Street; thence along Clifford
Street in a Northerly direction one hundred (100) feet

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said *Arthur Ford*, all of my right, title and interest and of said to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in *Brynnsville* Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

on the southeast corner of Jones and Oscar Streets, bounded as follows as shown by the City map of the City of Greenville: Beginning at the corner of said Streets and running thence with Oscar Street in an easterly direction fifty-four feet; thence with W. H. Woods line in a southwesterly direction eighty-five feet; thence with Eliza Conway's and Miss Bettie Bettsmire's lines seventy-seven feet and five inches in a southwesterly direction; thence in a northwesterly direction with Miss Bettie Bettsmire and Mrs. A. C. Davis's lines one hundred forty-four feet to Jones Street and thence with Jones Street in a northeasterly direction one hundred fifty-six feet and one inch to the beginning corner.
