in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said J. W. McNeill, as Executor and Trustee  
all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Cleveland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

In the second Ward of the city of Greenville known and designated as lot No. 1 of Block 4 of Bolles Addition to Greenville, according to a plat thereof recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances for said County and State, in Plat Book "D" at page 179, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit, Beginning at an iron pin on the northeast corner of Pettign and Toy Streets; and running thence N. 15° W. one hundred and twenty-six (126) feet and one (1) inch along Toy Street to an iron pin on a ten foot alley, thence N. 76° 45' E.
