 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. Burns, of the County of Greenville  
 in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars, and other considerations,  
 to me paid by Louise Mc Gee Williams,

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Louise Mc Gee Williams, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

In the first ward, City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to wit: Beginning at a stake, 34, on the south side of Hampton Avenue, the East corner of lot held by A. G. Lower to W. J. Davidson and Jesse W. Dinkin, by deed dated August 9th, 1907, and recorded in R. M. C. of title, Greenville County, in Book VVV, page 25; and runs thence with line of said lot South 5° 10' West one hundred sixty-seven (167) feet to a stake, 34; thence with line of same lot South 55° West twenty-three (23) feet to stake on right of way of Southern Railway; thence with line of right of way South 2-3° East twenty (20) feet to a stake, 34; thence leaving same, East sixty-one (61) feet to a stake; thence North 63-5° East one hundred fifty (150) feet to a stake on south side of Hampton Avenue; thence, with line of said Street, North 35-15' West fifty-five (55) feet to the beginning corner

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by A. G. Lower on the 16th day of August 1918, deed recorded in office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 23, Page 217.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said

Louise Mc Gee Williams, her heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Louise Mc Gee Williams, her heirs and assigns, against myself and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
