a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of Massachusetts and having its principal place of business at Worcester in the State of Massachusetts, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Dollars and other good and valuable consideration, DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto H.C. Bates and

A. C. Walker, All that piece parcel, or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina in the City of Greenville, on the east side of Main Street between Cobut and Broad Streets, beginning at a point on the south side of a brick wall, what is known as the Jennings Building, at the corner of lot of R.L. Mills, and running thence in an easterly direction with said wall line, at right angles with Main Street and along the south side of said brick wall one hundred forty-eight feet to a stake on line of J. Robert Martin; thence in a northerly direction parallel with Main Street, fifty-one and one-tenth feet to a stake on line of J. E. and Jane K. Service; thence in a westerly direction with the line of said Service one hundred forty-eight feet to Main Street in a southerly direction fifty-one and one-tenth feet to the beginning corner being the same lot I and conveyed to the grantor by William W. Carter by Deed dated the 1st day of April, 1914, and recorded on April 1st, 1914, in Book 29, Page 16 R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinabove named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

R. L. Justice, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated lying and being in the State and County aforesaid about 2 miles from the Greenville County courthouse, near the Turkey Springs and King River as lot No. 231 of the McLain Tract.
