a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty five hundred and forty (\$850.00) DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

P. H. Huster, all that certain lot of land situate in the City of Greenville, County, and State, South Carolina, known and designated as lot No. 24 of Block 11 of Wagle Park, as shown on plat recorded in the R. N. Co. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "C", page 28 and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pipe on the South side of Prentiss Avenue, corner of lot No. 21, and running thence with line of lot No. 21, S 30-15 W. 143.4 ft. to iron pipe on a 5 foot alley; thence with said alley N. 53-03 W. 59 ft. to iron pipe, corner of lot No. 23; thence with line of lot No. 23, N 23-55 E. 143.7 ft. to iron pipe on Prentiss Avenue; thence with said Avenue S 55-42 E. 26.7 ft. thence still with said Avenue S 53-06 E. 43.3 ft. to the beginning corner.

- 3) The property herein conveyed shall not be recut, nor subdivided so as to face any other direction than as shown on said plat.
- 4) No building shall be erected upon said property within 25 ft of the present line of Prentiss Avenue.
- 5) No building costing less than Twenty Five hundred (\$2500.00) Dollars shall be erected upon said lot other than out-building appurtenant to dwelling.
