P. Thairid*

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in said city of *Greenville*, County and State aforesaid, on the south side of Rose Avenue and having the following metes and bounds according to plat made by *P. C. Halloway*, and recorded in Plat Book "E" at page 41 in R. M.
