a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Ten dollars and other valuable consideration, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto...

James D. Neal, All that certain lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the east side of Mulberry Street in the City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a point on the east side of Mulberry Street 150 feet from Buncombe Street, and running thence in a southeasterly direction parallel with Buncombe Street 106 feet to a stake; thence in a northwesterly direction in a line parallel with Mulberry Street 60 feet to a stake on Mulberry Street; thence in a northwesterly direction with Mulberry Street 106 feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot conveyed to Neal-Pack Company by E.D.
