R. L. Ford, her heirs and assigns, all that lot of land situated in the State and County aforesaid near the Town of Greer, having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a point on Franklin Street and running thence S. 19° 30' 95 1/2 feet to Green Mill Line, thence along this line N. 54° 47' 56 1/2 feet to a stone; thence N. 53° 6' 108 feet to an iron pin on said Franklin Street, thence along this street 81 1/2 E. 82 1/2 feet to the beginning corner, containing fourteen one-hundredth acres.
