a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of *South Carolina*, and having its principal place of business at *Greenville*, in the State of *South Carolina*, for and in consideration of the sum of *Thirty Six Hundred & fifty Dollars (\$3600.00)* DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Caroline P. Taylor her heirs and assigns, All that piece or parcel of land situate in *Greenville* Township, *Greenville* County, State of *South Carolina*, situated lying and being in *Ward Five* in the city of *Greenville* County, all State agreed beginning at an iron post on *Westside* of *Pendleton Street*, corner of lot *One M.R.* *M. Neal*, thence with said *Pendleton Street* N^o. *66 1/4* W. *100 feet* to a post, thence *N. 21 40' E. 150 feet* to a post, thence *S. 66 1/4 E. 100 feet* to a post, thence *150 feet* to the beginning corner on *Pendleton Street* and being part of a lot conveyed to it by *Mary M. Allen* by deed dated *March 18th 1920* and record in Volume *125* Page *320* R.M.C. Office for *Greenville County*
