KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I Dorothy M. Barber of the
County of Greenville

in the State aforesaid,
for ~~1000~~ Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by David M. Plowden.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said David M. Plowden his, heirs and assigns, forever,
All that lot of land on the East side of David Street, in the
City and County of Greenville, State aforesaid and having
the following widths and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron
pipe on the East side of David Street which pipe is the North-
west corner of lot owned by A. S. David and running thence N.
74°15' W. 70 feet with David Street to an iron pipe at the corner
of David Street and a twenty (20ft) foot Alley, which belongs to
the City, thence with said alley N. 89°-8 E. 71.7 feet to an iron
pipe which is the corner of A. S. David's property; thence
running with his line S. 1°-40' E. 21.7 feet to an iron pipe which
is the Northeast corner of A. S. David's property; thence S. 05°45'
W. 155 feet with A. S. David's line to the beginning corner. The
same being the lot of land conveyed to me by Elizabeth
W. Long, by her deed dated February 1, 1919 and recorded in
R. M. & C. Office for Greenville County in Vol 44, page 389. As a
part of the consideration of this deed the said David M.
Plowden, Grantee, agrees to assume and pay a note of Three
Thousand (\$3,000.00) Dollars executed by me Dorothy M. Barber
to Mechanics Prepetual Building and Loan Association on Feb-
ruary 1, 1919, which is secured by a first mortgage of the
above described premises, recorded in R. M. & C. Office in Vol 76
page 44, with interest on said debt from date of this
deed until paid. And it is also understood and agreed
that the Grantee as a part of the consideration herein
expressed is to assume and pay a note of Twelve
hundred, Fifty (\$1,250.00) Dollars executed by the Grantee to
Elizabeth W. Long on February 1, 1919, which is secured by
a mortgage of above described premises recorded in R. M.
& C. Office in Vol 46 page 237, with interest from date of
this deed until paid.

It is further understood and agreed that all window
shades and window screens and also the Rudd heaters
on the said premises at the time the contract
under which this Deed is now made June 6, 1919, shall
pass under this Deed to the Grantee free of all additional
cost to him. It is further understood and agreed that
all County and State taxes are to be paid on a pro
rata basis for 1919, and that the Grantee is to pay
all city taxes for 1919.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining,
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said

David M. Plowden, his

heirs and assigns, forever.

heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said David M. Plowden,
