in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of One DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by J. C. Eppel

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

J. C. Eppel, all that certain piece of land containing 0.22 acres, more or less, in 5th public Township known as lot no. 2 of the lands of Sarah A. Eppel Jordan and described as follows: Beginning in center of Pelzer road thence N. 53 1/4 E. 19.78 to stake, thence N. 46 W. 12.44 to stake, thence S. 53 1/4 E. 8.50 to stake, thence S. 37 W. 11.50 to iron pin, Pelzer road, thence with said road 818 chains to the beginning corner.
A right of way for a road on the line between lot no. 2 and lots no. 1 and 5 to the Pelzer road for an outlet for lots 3, 4 and 5 is reserved.
