 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That L. H. Stringer and James
 I West of the County and in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of Six thousand three hundred sixty eight and 75/100 DOLLARS,
 to Boaz L. Ridgeway in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by Boaz L. Ridgeway

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

Boaz L. Ridgeway, his heirs and assigns all those two certain tracts or parcels of land situate about five miles East of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the Scuffletown Road, known as tract No. one and two respectively, in a division of the lands of J. A. Green as shown for plat of same by W. D. Neves, Engineer, October 10th, 1912, and bearing the following corner and bounds to wit:

Tract No. One. Beginning at a stone on Scuffletown road near the five mile branch, and running thence North 25.30 West 2.60 to a stone; thence South 3.810 West 2.56 to a stone in the five mile branch; thence South 2.5.50 East 19.85 to a stone on settlement road; thence with said road North 15.20 East 14.00 to a stone in bend of the road; thence North 17.20 East 7.22 to a stone on the Scuffletown road; thence with the Scuffletown road North 83.30 West 10.30 to the beginning corner, containing fifteen and 1/10 (15.8) acres, more or less.

Tract No. Two. Beginning at a stone on Scuffletown road, at junction of settlement road, thence South eighty seven degrees, thirty minutes East 10.75 to a cedar; thence East wardly to a red oak; thence South ten degrees, forty minutes West 3.56 to a stone; thence South fifteen degrees forty minutes West 6.92 to a S. oak; thence South nineteen degrees twenty minutes West 2.83 to Red Oak; thence South thirty two degrees, forty minutes West 3.92 to a stone; thence South ten degrees ten minutes West 13.25 to a stone corner; thence South sixty six degrees, thirty minutes West 5.70 to a stone; thence North twenty five degrees, fifty minutes West 13.11 to a stake on Settlement Road; thence with Settlement road North fifteen degrees, twenty minutes East 14.00 to a stake in said road; thence North seventeen degrees, twenty minutes East 7.23 to the beginning stone, containing thirty five and 15/100 (35.15) acres, more or less, and being the said two tracts of land conveyed to us by deed from J. Gault, bearing date the 1st of August 1912 and recorded in Office of R. M. C. for said County in Deed Book Vol. 51 page 168.
