on the north side of Earle Street and west side of Wilton  
Street, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:  
Beginning at the north west corner of Earle and Wil-  
ton Streets, and running thence with Wilton Street, N.  
5 1/2 E. 200 feet to a stake; thence with the line of lands  
now or formerly owned by the Stone Land Company, N. 84 1/2  
W. 54 1/3 feet to a stake; thence in a line parallel with Wil-  
ton Street S. 5 1/2 W. 200 feet to a stake on Earle Street; thence  
with Earle Street, S. 84 1/2 E. 54 1/3 feet to the beginning cor-
