D. H. Moore and J. N. Bell, all that tract of land situated
in the State and County aforesaid on Rutherford Road about
three miles from Greenville Court House and being a part
of the tract of land conveyed by Wilhelmina Schaffler to L. G.
Cole November 3, 1873, by deed recorded in Vol. F.F., page 142
R. M. C. Records for Greenville County containing five (5)
acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds
to-wit: Beginning at an apple tree corner S. 10° W. 70°. Survey
line and running thence N. 24° 23' W. 352.3' to peg in center
of road and W. 70° Survey line; thence down road S. 56.0.0 W
854.27 feet to peg in road; thence S. 43.30 E. 642.5' to iron pin
on W. 70° Survey line; thence N. 13.45 E. 493.2 feet to beginning
as shown by plat made by L. P. Shetter September 14, 1911.
This being the same tract of land conveyed to Jane E.
Kellett by J. W. Graymaster, by deed dated September 15, 1911
and recorded in Vol. 14 page 278, R. M. C. Records for
Greenville County. Also all that tract of land adjoining the
above described tract containing two and two tenths (2.2)

bounds to-wit: Beginning at iron pin on Rutherford Road
corner of Jane E. Kellett's land and running thence west
