*of Greenville*in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
Ten Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,
to **71st** in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by *S. B. Atkinson*

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

S. B. Atkinson, his heirs and assigns forever,
All that piece of land or lot of land situated on East
Stone Avenue, and having the following metes and bounds:
Beginning on South Side of East Stone Avenue about one
hundred and twenty-two feet from the corner of said Stone
Avenue and Riddle Street, and running thence with
said Stone Avenue S. 69-29 E 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ to an iron pin on
Stone Avenue; thence S. 20-19 N. 175 feet to an iron pin;
thence parallel with said Avenue N. 69-29 W. 58 $\frac{1}{2}$
feet to an iron pin; thence N. 20-19 E. 175 feet to begin-
ning corner on Stone Avenue. This being the same lot
of land conveyed to us by J. Hudson Williams on the
12th day of Jan. 1916 our said deed being recorded in
the P. M. Office in and for Greenville County,
